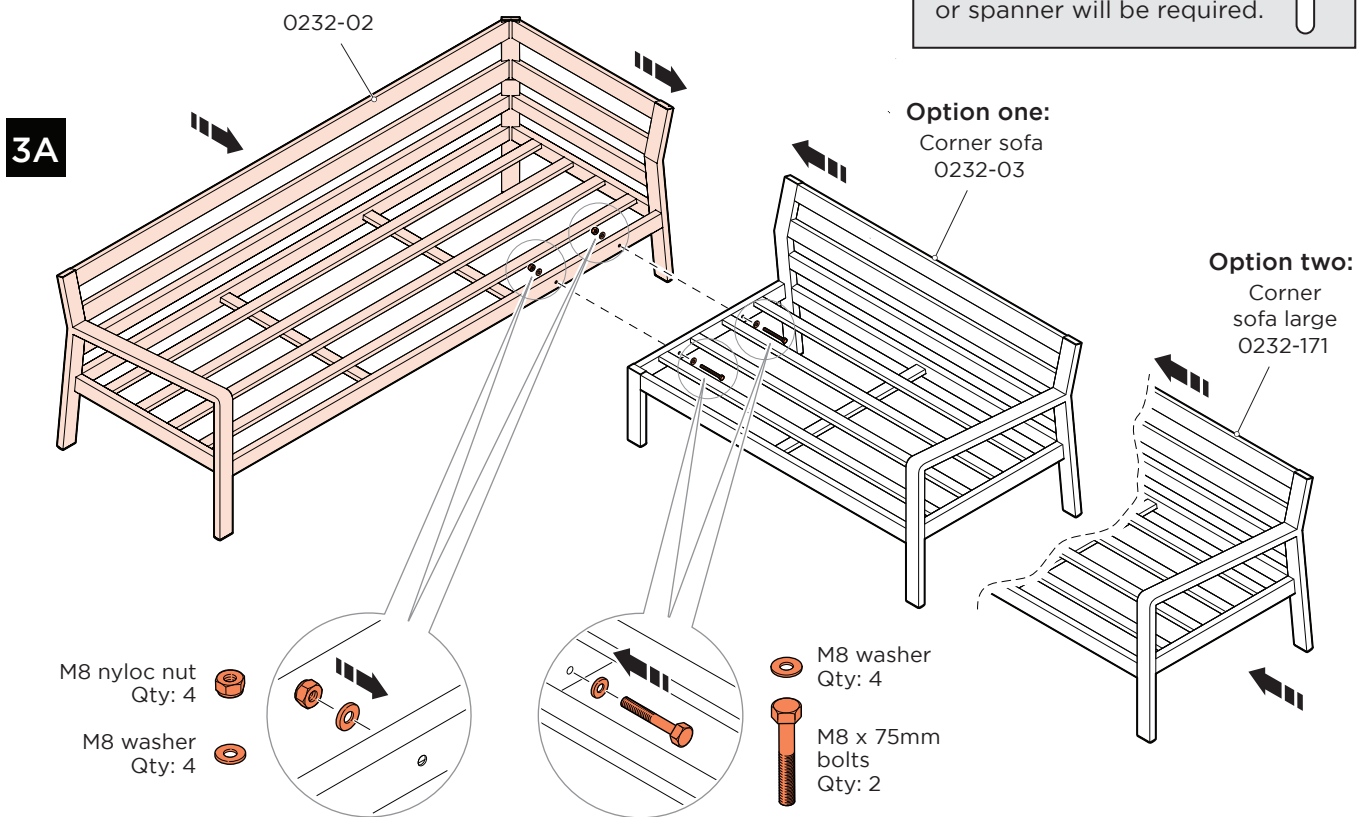

3. Corner Sofa Assembly

 **Warning:** Due to the weight of the sofa, lifting procedure requires a minimum of two people. 

Tool needed: 13mm socket or spanner will be required. 

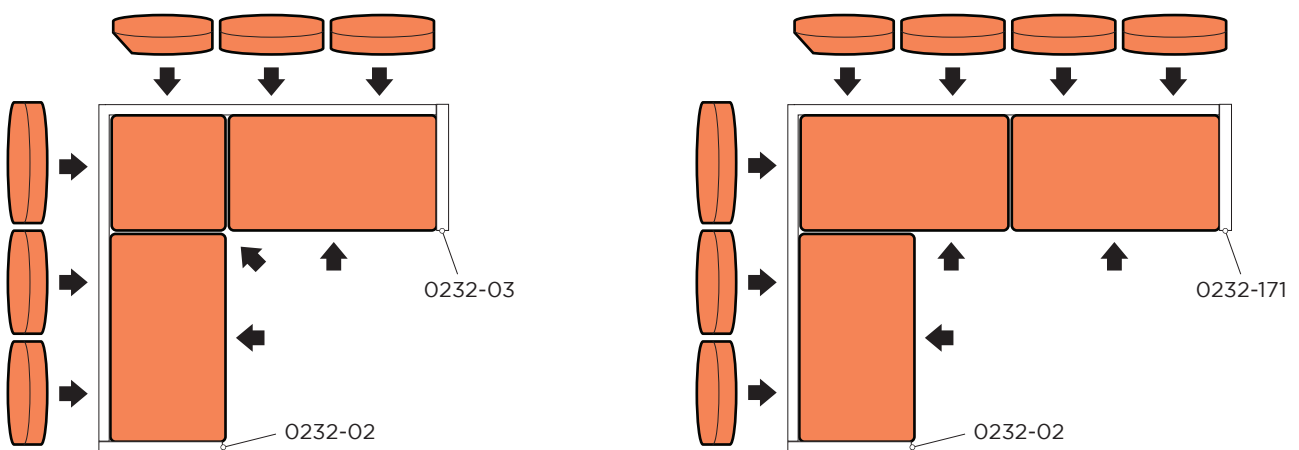


1. Join the frames together using the fixings shown above (fig. 3A).
2. **Note:** Part 0232-02 is common to both corner sofa sets and is used to connect either part 0232-03 or part 0232-171, depending on the sofa configuration purchased.

Corner Sofa Cushion Arrangements.

Depending on the sofa purchased, cushion configuration will consist of either 9 or 10 cushions.

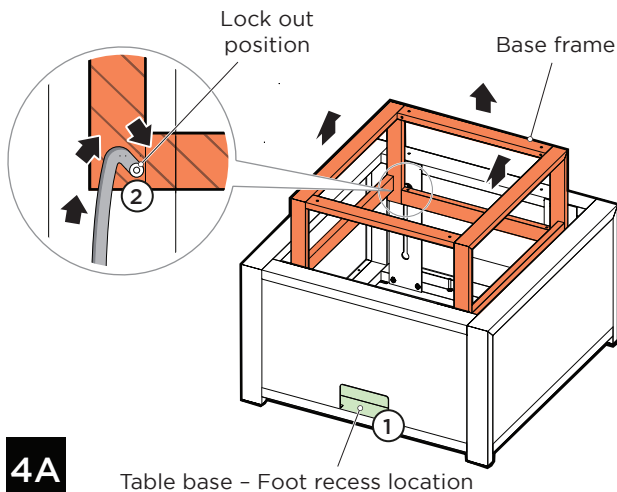


Option one: Corner Sofa Set (9 Cushions)

4. Dual Height Square Table Assembly

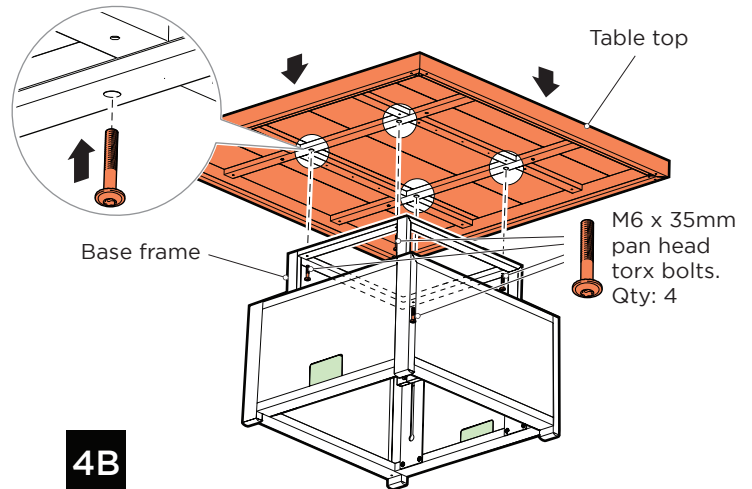
Warning: Due to the weight of the table, lifting procedure requires a minimum of two people.

Table base - Foot recess location

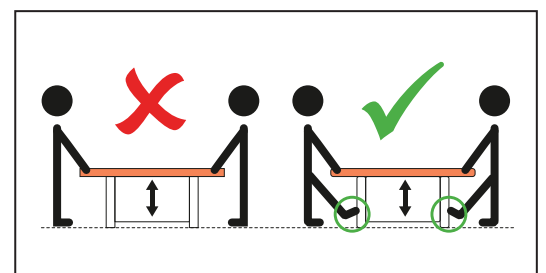


Fig.6 - Correct way of lifting / lowering the table top.

1. Place one foot into each table recess on adjacent sides. This will help stabilise the table base, when lifting (Fig.6).
2. Raise the internal base frame in an upward direction until it reaches the maximum height and locks into position.

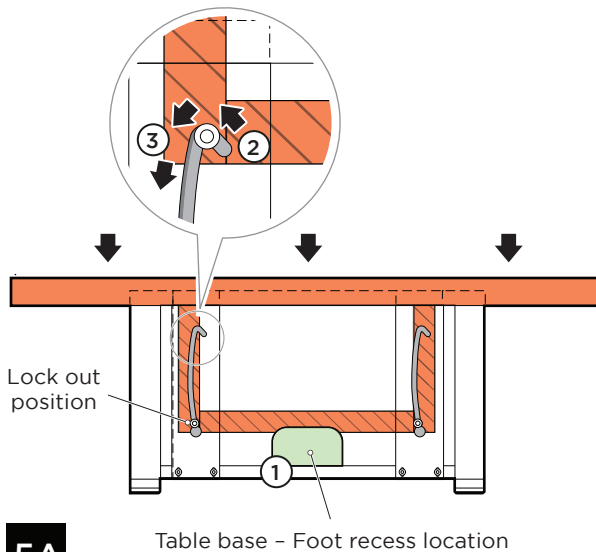
Carefully position the table top onto the base frame, ensuring all fixing points are correctly aligned. Secure the table top using the provided fixing bolts, as shown above.

Securing table base -
M6x 35mm flanged button bolts.
Tools required: 5mm hex bit
or T25 / T30 torx bit.



Operation Procedure to Change Table Height

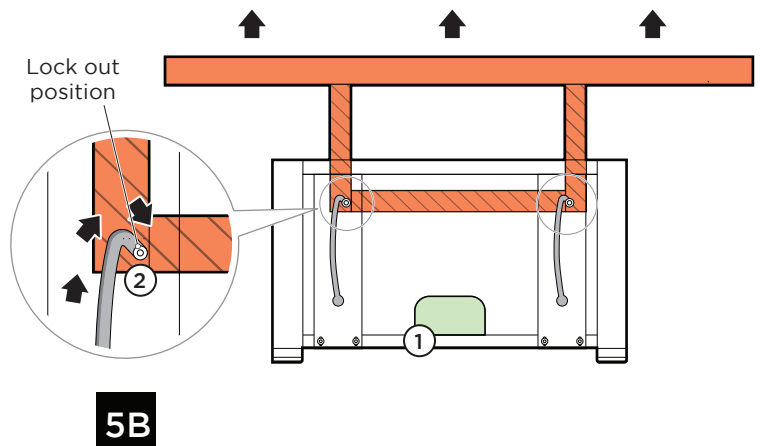
Coffee table position

To adjust to minimum height - coffee table position (Fig. 5A).

1. Place one foot into each table recess on adjacent sides. This will help stabilise the table base, when lowering (Fig.6).
2. Lift slightly upwards to unlock table top.
3. Lower gently in a downwards direction, until the table top stops.

To adjust to maximum height - dinning table position (Fig. 5B).

1. Place one foot into each table recess on adjacent sides of the table. This will help stabilise the table base, when lifting (Fig.6).
2. Raise the table top in an upward direction until it reaches the maximum height and locks into position.

7. Assembly Guidelines

Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use.

- Before assembling your garden furniture, ensure all plastic wrapping and protective film are fully removed. Removal of clutter, debris and sharp objects, to reduce damaging components during assembly.
- Find a large, clean, and level surface to assemble your garden furniture. ensure you have enough space to work safely and efficiently.
- Some components of your furniture can be large or heavy. For safety and ease, we recommend having two people assemble the product. This helps prevent injury and reduces the risk of damaging parts during assembly.
- Handle with care: Avoid dragging pieces across hard surfaces. Lift and position components gently to avoid injury or damage,
- Follow the assembly instructions and use the recommended tools. Avoid improvising with sharp instruments that could scratch and damage the furniture or cause injury.
- Always wear appropriate safety gloves during assembly, some edges and corners may be sharp and can cause minor cuts if handled without protection.
- Each component is designed to fit smoothly, forcing parts may result in damage to the furniture.
- When applicable, tighten all components by hand first. Once all steps are completed, go back and fully tighten till firmly secure with the recommended handtool.
- **Note:** For specific guidance relating to fire pit table assembly, please refer to the separate manual.

PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT

We advise appropriate personal protective equipment is worn during assembly.



Congratulations on purchasing your new HEX Living product.

Designed and built to stand the test of time, HEX Living products are low maintenance; requiring little more than a periodic clean to keep them looking their very best.

Here's some advice on how to look after your items:

- Regularly wipe down metal frames with detergent-free, warm soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge to clean. Avoid using bleach, abrasive cleaners or pressure washing.
- Perform maintenance checks at least once a year and ensure all fixings are secure.
- Clean cushions using a soft brush and a mild fabric cleaner.
- To avoid permanent stains, clean up spillages immediately.
- Always dry your furniture completely to prevent moisture build-up, especially before covering or storing.
- Place coasters beneath glasses and tableware to prevent the marking your table top.

Important information

- Please open with care, avoid using sharp tools like Stanley knives or scissors, as they may accidentally damage your new garden furniture. Such damage is not covered under warranty.
- We recommend you use covers to protect your outdoor furniture from weather damage, when not in use. Covers must be removed periodically to minimise moisture build up.
- Remove garden furniture covers with care, whilst durable, they can rip when removed with excessive force.

8.2. Care Advice - Outdoor Cushion Precautions

Outdoor cushions are designed for comfort and style, but they're not totally weatherproof. Prolonged exposure to moisture and direct sunlight can lead to water damage, mould and fading. Our outdoor cushions have UV-Resistant and shower-proof qualities, however they are only designed to handle occasional exposure to moisture, and are not designed to withstand heavy downpours.

To protect from cushions from weather-damage, consider these simple precautions:

- **Storage:** Use a waterproof deck box, shed or bring cushions indoors during heavy downpours.
- **Covers:** Consider purchasing our HEX Living made-to-measure removable covers, made from high quality waterproof fabric, washable and long lasting, see page 6 for more details.
- **Drying:** After exposure to moisture, unzip and air-dry cushions completely.
- **Clean regularly:** Wipe down with mild soap and water; avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Elevate off wet surfaces:** Prevent water pooling and mildew by keeping cushions raised.



White Residue: Our outdoor cushions have been treated with a fire-retardant protective barrier, so sometimes after drying you may notice small white patches on your cushions. These can easily be removed by using a clean, damp cloth to gently rub the affected area.

Once wiped clean allow the cushion to air dry naturally. Repeat the process if any white patches remain, until they are fully removed. This simple cleaning method should help restore your cushions to their intended appearance.

By following these simple steps: Your outdoor cushions should stay dry and protected from water damage — season after season.

9. Limited Warranty

HEX Living products are supplied with a lifetime warranty on all metal components and a one-year warranty on cushions, gas, and mechanical elements, commencing from the date of purchase.

The warranty covers manufacturing defects and faulty components and extends to the replacement of these parts only. Costs associated with shipping, installation, replacement of worn parts, and any other related expenses are not covered under this warranty.

The warranty will be void in cases of misuse, mishandling, or if any unauthorised modifications have been made to the product.
