


3. Corner Sofa Assembly





Tool needed: 13mm socket or spanner will be required.



Locate and secure frame together using the fixings shown above.







Locate and secure M6 x 35mm pan head torx bolts to table top as shown above.

Locate and secure 4x Torx M6 x 35mm flanged bolts. As shown above. Tool required: M6 Torx screwdriver.

Operation Procedure to Change Table Height




Fig.4 - Table in coffee table position.




Fig.5 - Table in dinning position.

This procedure will require two people.



To lower to minimum height (coffee table position) (Fig.4).




Fig.6 - Correct way of lifting / lowering the table top.

- 1. Place a foot in both table recesses at adjacent sides (Fig.6). (these will help steady the table base, when lifting).
- 2 Lift slightly upwards to unlock table top.
- 3. Lower gently in a downwards direction, until the table top stops.

To lift table to maximum height (dinning height position) (Fig.5).

- 1. Place a foot in both table recesses at adjacent sides (Fig.6). (these will help steady the table base, when lifting).
- 2. Lift table to maximum height, lift in an upwards direction until table locks outs.

6. Assembly Guidelines

Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use.

- Make sure all plastic protection is removed before assembling.
- Assembly of the product involves some large components; it is advisable to have two people assemble the unit.
- Find a large, clean area to assemble your product.
- Assembly should be carried out on an open, flat, level surface.
- Please refer to the parts list and assembly diagram as necessary.
- To avoid losing any small component or hardware, assemble your product on a hard level surface that does not have cracks or openings.
- To prevent any possible damage to the flooring structure, ensure this product is correctly lifted, whilst been moved from one position to another.
- Follow all steps in order to properly assemble your product.
- Wear correct safety gloves. Edges and corners can cause minor cuts if improperly handled during assembly.
- Do not force parts together as this can result in damage to the product.
- When applicable, tighten all components by hand first. Once all steps are completed, go back and fully tighten till firmly secure with the recommended handtool.
- For specific guidance relating to fire pit table assembly, please refer to the separate manual.

TWO PERSON ASSEMBLY

Most procedures will not require two people but it may be easier to have assistance.

7. Care Advice

Congratulations on purchasing your new HEX Living product.

Designed and built to stand the test of time, HEX Living products are low maintenance; requiring little more than a periodic clean to keep them looking their very best.

Here's some advice on how to look after your items:

- 1. Regularly wipe down metal frames with detergent-free, warm soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge to clean. Avoid using heavy detergents or power washers.
- 2. Perform maintenance checks at least once a year and ensure all fixings are secure.
- 3. Clean cushions using a soft brush and a fabric cleaner.
- 4. To avoid permanent stains, clean up spillages immediately.
- 5. Cover your furniture set when not in use to avoid damage.
- 6. Place coasters beneath glasses and tableware to prevent the marking your table top

Important Information

- Open with care: Using a Stanley knife or scissors whilst opening the packaging may cause accidental damage to your new garden furniture set. This will not be covered by your warranty.
- We recommend you use covers to protect your outdoor furniture when not in use. Covers must be removed periodically to minimise moisture build up.
- Remove garden furniture covers with care: Whilst durable, they can rip when removed with excessive force.

8. Limited Warranty

HEX Living products come with a lifetime warranty on all metal components and a one year warranty on fire pit elements, commencing from the date of purchase. The warranty includes manufacturing deficiencies and defective parts and extends to the replacement of these parts. Expenses for shipping, installation, replacement of worn parts and other cost are not covered by the warranty. The warranty lapses in case of mishandling and if any kind of unauthorised modifications are made to the appliance.
