A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

AS MANY OF OUR SHEDS UTILISE COMMON PARTS, WE TOOK THE DECISION TO RESTRUCTURE THE PACKING INTO SMALLER AND LIGHTER BOXES. THE OVERALL AIM WAS TO SIMPLIFY THE PROCESS OF LOCATING THE CORRECT PARTS DURING THE SHED BUILDING PROCESS.

FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES EACH BOX HAS A **UNIQUE ID CODE**, THE LIST BELOW SHOWS WHAT ORDER THESE SHOULD BE OPENED WHEN BUILDING YOUR SHED;

F* - FLOOR RAILS (INC. FIXING KIT)

P* - CORNER POSTS

W* - WALL PANELS (TYPICALLY THREE BOXES)

I* - INFILL PANELS

T* - ROOF TRIM


R* - ROOF PANELS

D* - DOORS



EXAMPLE ID LABEL

EACH BOX IS CLEARLY LABELLED WITH A WHITE STICKER AS PER EXAMPLE BELOW. THIS CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING USEFUL INFORMATION.



ALSO THINK ABOUT HOW TO MAINTAIN YOUR WORKSPACE

- 1. DURING THE SHED BUILDING PROCESS, WE WOULD RECOMMEND KEEPING UNUSED BOXES AWAY FROM THE ASSEMBLY AREA TO REDUCE CLUTTER.
- 2. WHILST THE BOXES AND INTERNAL PACKAGING OFFER GREAT PROTECTION, PLEASE ENSURE THE ASSEMBLY AREA IS KEPT CLEAN AND FREE OF DEBRIS.
- 3. CAREFULLY REVIEW YOUR HEX LIVING ASSEMBLY GUIDE, PRIOR TO STARTING THE SHED ASSEMBLY.
